

YOUTH WORKERS PRAYER PAPER JUNE 2018
Pray for the Youth Workers, Young People,
Organisations, Activities and Concerns listed for each day
of the Month of June

Friday 1st June *General* On this the first day of a new month pray for all the Youth Workers involved with Faith in Scarborough Schools, Sidewalk and the Scarborough link with Stepping Stones in Ranaghat, India. Pray for the young people that they meet and have dealings with.

Saturday 2nd June *General* Behind all the contact with young people there is much administrative work that depends upon office space and equipment. Pray for all the facilities required that they function and operate well and give thanks that Sidewalk and Faith in Scarborough Schools now have office space at Albermarle Baptist Church on Albermarle Crescent in the centre of town.

Sunday 3rd June *Faith in Scarborough Schools (FISS)* John, Geoff, Helen, and Lisa have been appointed to FISS as new Trustees have been appointed to Faith in Scarborough Schools. Please pray for each of them individually along with the trustees as a whole as plans can now go forward in appointing a new worker for FISS when Bruce retires. Pray for the job application design, its distribution and God's guidance in determining the right person for the post.

Monday 4th June *FISS and Sidewalk* Teaching begins today in schools for the final half term of the academic year. Pray over the mentoring work that Sidewalk gives to students with problems in secondary education and lift up Bruce in prayer as he leads assembly at Barrowcliffe School this morning at 09.00hrs. At 15.00hrs this afternoon Bruce will be with Catherine for the Bramcote Fruit Loop Session until 16.15hrs

Tuesday 5th June *Sidewalk* At 18.00hrs this evening Sidewalk will be holding a Group Team Meeting for all group-work staff and volunteers. Pray for all involved and ask the Lord to guide the way forward for present and future group-work. *Bruce Clark* Bruce begins his day with 7.00a.m prayers before spending the time from 10.00hrs to 15.15hrs at Lindhead School's Diversity Day. Pray for the children, the school staff and all who take part in the event.

Wednesday 6th June *Bruce Clark* Wheatcroft School assembly will be led by Bruce at 10.00hrs this morning. At 12.30hrs Bruce will be in charge of the Newby School Rock Solid Club, which is proving more and more popular amongst the students. Pray that the Rock Solid Club may continue after Bruce retires.

Thursday 7th June *Sidewalk* From 18.30hrs to 21.30hrs Sidewalk will hold a detached team meeting and session for all detached staff and volunteers. Please hold the work of the detached team in your prayers as this work is at the cutting edge of meeting with young people in need in Scarborough. *Bruce Clark* From 11.40hrs to 12.30hrs today Bruce will be at the Cambian Centre helping the special needs students there to develop as whole caring individuals with an opportunity for joy and wonder in their lives. This evening Bruce will be with the Sidewalk detached team meeting.

Friday 8th June *Bruce Clark* Support Bruce in prayer as he attends a three-day Conference on "Teach us to Pray". *Sidewalk* Steve Blower and Steve Phipps of the Sidewalk Street Team will be on the streets of Scarborough this evening meeting with young people with offers of friendship, advice and support. Pray for the young people they will meet with and hold in your prayers the increasing number of young people who lose hope of finding secure employment.

Saturday 9th June *Bruce Clark* Continue praying for Bruce and the part he is led to follow in the "Teach us to Pray Conference. May he be able to share with others the power of prayer he has experienced in his life and the lives of those he has brought the love of God to.

Sunday 10th June *Bruce Clark* As the "Teach us to Pray Conference" draws to a close hold Bruce and all that attended in your prayers as, although joyful, such conferences can often be very spiritually demanding leaving one wonderfully uplifted and exhausted at the same time.

Monday 11th June *Sidewalk* This evening from 18.30hrs to 20.00hrs the Gym Group meet again in Body Talk's Gym. Give thanks that the group are welcome in the Gym each Monday and pray that the Group make good use of it and thoroughly enjoy the approved exercises and activities, many of which are designed by members of the Group. *Bruce Clark* At 15.00hrs this afternoon Bruce will be meeting with Catherine Duffy to lead another "Fruit Loop" session for the children of Bramcote School as a part of the Christian course on the Fruits of the Spirit.

Tuesday 12th June *Bruce Clark* After prayers at 7.00hrs this morning Bruce will be leading 08.30hrs assembly at Bramcote School before driving to East Ayton School to give assembly there at 10.00hrs. In the afternoon Bruce will be teaching and playing the guitar with the special needs young people at the Cambian Centre. *Sidewalk* From 12.30hrs to 13.30hrs Steve Blower will be attending a meeting with representatives of Churches Together in Scarborough (CTIS). Pray that the outcome of this meeting will be beneficial for Sidewalk. This evening Catherine and Mandy will be with the Tuesday Group supervising their art and craftwork.

Wednesday 13th June *Bruce Clark* Today Bruce will lead 09.00hrs assembly at Overdale School to be followed by leading Newby School Rock Solid Club from 12.30hrs to 13.00hrs. He will then visit St. Martin's School to take their afternoon assembly at 14.45hrs.

Thursday 14th June *Sidewalk* From 7.00pm until 10.00pm Catherine and Bruce will be carrying out detached youth work on the streets, along the sea front and in the parks of Scarborough to be on hand in order to help and befriend young people in need. Pray that they may be led to those who are desperate for help and advice some of which are already known to Sidewalk and are being helped, but there are many others that would benefit from contact with Sidewalk.

Friday 15th June *Sidewalk* Steve Blower and Steve Phipps will be on detached youth work this evening visiting places where young people congregate in Scarborough and meeting with some who Sidewalk are already helping.

Saturday 16th June *Stepping Stones Ministry* Continue praying for the work in India founded by Richard and Tracy Pashby of Scarborough. Children's homes, clean water for the villages, discipleship, education and training, protection from human trafficking, development of mission teams and provision of relief in natural disaster all come under the umbrella of Stepping Stones Ministry in the Ranaghat area of West Bengal.

Sunday 17th June *Sidewalk* Pray for Steve Blower as he gives a presentation on the work of Sidewalk this evening to Burniston Methodist Church's Sunday at 8 meeting.

Monday 18th June *Sidewalk* Gym Club members are making good progress with improving their fitness and engaging in friendly competition with regard to their workouts. The Group is proving to be very popular and members are very innovative in trying out new timed sessions of exercise. *Bruce Clark* Braeburn Infants School assembly will be taken by Bruce this morning at 10.00hrs to be followed in the afternoon by Braeburn Junior School assembly at 14.40hrs after which he and Cathy will run another Bramcote Fruitloop Session on the Fruit of the Spirit from 15.00hrs to 16.30hrs.

Tuesday 19th June *Bruce Clark* After Tuesday morning prayers Bruce will travel to Wykeham School to lead assembly at 10.00hrs. In the afternoon he will be with the Cambian Centre young people with his guitar giving further lessons and playing for them. *Sidewalk* This evening Catherine, Sarah and Liza will be running the Tuesday Group. Give thanks that this Group is so popular and continue praying for the young people.

Wednesday 20th June *Bruce Clark* Wheatcroft School assembly will be taken by Bruce at 10.00hrs this morning before driving to Newby School to lead their lunch-time Rock Solid Club from 12.30hrs to 13.00hrs.

Thursday 21st June *Sidewalk* Detached Youth Work will be carried out this evening by Catherine and Steve Phipps. Pray that the Lord will lead them not only to those places where young people congregate but also to the places where young people seek to be alone with their problems. *Bruce Clark* This morning Bruce will visit Cayton School to lead assembly there at 09.00hrs before travelling to Brompton by Sawdon Primary School to take their afternoon assembly at 13.00hrs.

Friday 22nd June *Bruce Clark* Seamer and Irton School assembly will be led by Bruce this morning at 09.00hrs after which he will prepare for Detached Youth Work this evening with Steve Blower. *Sidewalk* Bruce and Steve Blower will be on Detached Youth Work this evening meeting with young people in need, befriending them and helping them with their concerns, hopes and disappointments. Pray for this work, which has proved valuable for the wellbeing of so many young people in the past.

Saturday 23rd June *Fruitloop* Fruitloop is not restricted to one school and is still in the experimental stage. Catherine with her dancing skills wanted to take the idea of the "Fruits Of The Spirit" with children, working with them to create dance moves related to subjects such as love, peace, kindness, faithfulness and patience etc. Bruce designed

activities and discussions around each theme. The first six-week series was taken at Seamer and Irton School. It was very successful and the young people who participated wanted us to come back. This term Bruce and Cathy's Fruitloop sessions are taking place at Bramcote School. Hold this wonderful Christian learning activity in your prayers.

Sunday 24th June *General* Bruce states 'there is possibly no greater catchment in terms of sharing the teaching of the Bible than the school assembly. The Education Reform Act requires predominant Christian teaching in assemblies. Where else will you find 300 people on a weekday obligated to hear about the teachings of Jesus? Through Faith in Scarborough Schools well over a thousand children, along with their teachers, are hearing the Good News of God's love! each week.' Monday 25th June *Sidewalk* This evening from 18.00hrs to 19.00hrs Sidewalk's Gym Group takes place again at Bodtorque Gym for young people from 16 to 18yrs old. Give thanks for the initiative the members are taking in improving their health and hold them in your prayers. *Bruce Clark* This morning Bruce will travel to Staxton to lead 09.15hrs assembly at Hertford Vale School. In the afternoon he will give assembly at Hunmanby School at 14.45 before meeting with Cathy and the Bramcote Fruitloop Group at 15.00hrs.

Tuesday 26th June *Bruce Clark* Following Morning Prayer Bruce will visit Bramcote School to take their morning assembly at 08.30hrs. At 15.00hrs this afternoon Bruce will give assembly at Snainton School. *Sidewalk* Mandy and Catherine will be out on detached youth work from 19.00hrs to 22.00hrs this evening. Pray for the young people they meet with asking the Lord to guide those with concerns and bring them in trust to the help of Sidewalk.

Wednesday 27th June *Bruce Clark* Overdale School assembly will be led by Bruce at 09.00hrs this morning, afterwards he will visit Newby School to head up lunch-time Rock Solid Club from 12.30hrs to 13.00hrs before taking assembly at St. Martin's School at 14.45hrs.

Thursday 28th June *Sidewalk* Catherine and Steve Blower will be together carrying out Sidewalk detached youth work this evening. Hold them and the young people they meet with in prayer as they seek to help those young people who are in despair and need on the streets, along the sea front, in the parks and shelters of Scarborough.

Friday 29th. June *Sidewalk* Detached youth work will be carried out by Bruce, Catherine and Sarah this evening. Pray that they may be instrumental in helping some of the young people of Scarborough who are in real need.

Saturday 30th June *General* Pray for all the school students who are taking O and A level exams, particularly those who will be hoping for results that will win them a place at university or other institutes of further education. Pray also for those young people who will be looking to find employment on leaving school. Pray that they will not be disheartened and feel unwanted.
